Berm & Dump Site Safety

- Berms must be as high as the axle of the largest piece of mobile equipment traveling the roadway.
- Report any section of elevated roadway that is not bermed.
- Whenever haulage trucks dump on stockpiles, a berm must be provided on the ramp and edge of stockpile.
- Ramps and dumping facilities shall be designed and constructed of materials capable of supporting the loads to which they will be subjected.
- Dumping locations shall be visually inspected prior to work commencing and as ground conditions warrant.
- When Possible, enter the dump site from the cab side to inspect the area for hazards before dumping.
